The regular meeting of the Eldridge Park Board was called to order at 6:30 P.M. on March 11, 2025, at City Hall.

Board members present were Jeff Ashcraft, Jill DeWulf, Tricia Campbell, Dean Halverson, and Scott LaPlante. Also present were Angie Harten, Mick Reagan, Henry Latham, Scott Campbell, Tony Rupe and Ashley Lacey.

Motion by DeWulf, second by T. Campbell to approve the agenda. Motion was approved unanimously by voice vote.

Motion by T. Campbell, second by Laplante to approve the minutes from the February 18, 2025, meeting. Motion approved unanimously by voice vote.

Motion by DeWulf, second by LaPlante to approve bills payable in the amount of \$588.53. Motion approved unanimously by voice vote.

Old Business-

Hickory Creek Soccer Field- There was damage at the soccer fields due to someone driving on the grass, the board would like to have Rupe get some quotes for security purposes and then present them at the next meeting. These would include fencing in the soccer fields, adding gates to the entrances, large boulders to block the field, checking on a different hot spot for cameras, and adding signage about no vehicles allowed on the field.

Walking Path at Hickory Creek - DeWulf presented a proposal from Crystal Rosplock for a Walking Trail at Hickory Creek. Motion by T. Campbell, second by LaPlante to hire Rosplock to design the walking path. Motion approved unanimously by voice vote, and Dewulf abstained from the vote.

Bandshell Update- Ashcraft let the board know a General Contractor was hired for the building of the bandshell. He also let the board know that the wetland study came back and was good.

New Business-


Crandall Park Restrooms- Rupe is acquiring a quote for a bathroom at Crandall, with the quote Jeff Martens will be submitting grant requests.

Job Specification: Fence and gate options at sorrer fields.

Option 1- Approx. 1,770 blocking off parking lot from field.

- Three 16' double double drive gates. Ones at SW and NE corners of parking lot. One at the irrigation box.
- 3' pedestrian openings approx. every 100'.

4' commercial galvanized= \$27,850.00

4' commercial black= \$35,480.00

6' commercial galvanized= \$34,225.00

6' commercial black= \$41,740.00

Option 2- Approx. 3,200' around the entire soccer complex and blocking off parking lot.

- Three 16' double drive gates. Ones at SW and NE corners of parking lot. One at the irrigation box.
- 3' pedestrian openings approx. every 100' along parking lot sides.

4' commercial galvanized= \$43,985.00

4' commercial black= \$55,330.00

6' commercial galvanized= \$54,060.00

6' commercial black= \$66,960.00

Option 3- Install two sets of 65' wide double swing arm gates across driveways.

- Use 6 5/8" full weight pipe with proper sized concrete footings for gates to hang on.
- Use 180 degree hinges and hold backs to hold gates in open postion.
- Locking double drive gate latch for when gates are closed.

4' commercial galvanized= \$9,970.00 4' commercial black= \$11,130.00

Option 4- Install two sets of 65' wide double swing arm gates across driveways.

- Make one wing of one of the double gates a roller gate.
- Add LiftMaster CSL24UL commercial slide gate operator.
- Supply and install:- Safety Photo Eyes
 - 7 Day Timer
 - 5 Single Button Transmitters
 - Free Exit Loop and Loop Detector.



- Second set of double swing arm gates will be the same as option 3.





If you just need Internet there and not transport back to city hall, this would likely be an application for our 100/100 Mb Business Internet Service at \$99.95. Lead time on the new fiber build would be around 30 days.



We have been replacing or repairing the wind screens at the Sheridan Meadows pickleball courts on a regular basis. With the courts being on the edge of Eldridge, they are subject to high winds with no wind breaks.

We have discussed, as a staff, replacing the wind screens with fence slats. The fence slats would be durable and would withstand the wind without damage.

We considered replacing just the south side with fence slats, as those screens have been damaged beyond repair, to see how they look and how effective they are at blocking the wind compared to the wind screens. One concern with this would be that the players on the south court would be looking at wind screens when facing one direction and looking at fence slats facing the other direction. Additionally, I anticipate that the fence slats will lessen the ability to see inside the courts, as the wind screens are somewhat transparent.

Our staff would like direction on how the Park Board would like to proceed. Options include:

- 1) Installing fence slats on a trial basis
- 2) Continue repairing and replacing the wind screens as needed
- 3) Any other options?

I reached out to Sampson Fence on a price for fence slats. To do the entire fence, the materials are \$4,440 and the labor to install is \$4,680. I believe our staff could do the labor.
